2. Educational Support

Evaluation: Four years ago, the European Schools introduced a new **Educational Support policy** replacing what was known as "rattrapage" and SEN-policy, with the intention to make support more flexible and child oriented. The first full evaluation of its implementation is now on-going across all the European Schools. To prepare to give a truthful and critical feedback to the inspectors for educational support from the parents' perspective, we will soon address a **fully anonymous questionnaire** to all parents. We hope in a numerous participation of all parents having, or having had in the past, experience with any form of educational support for their children, be it general, moderate or intensive support.

4. CoMoNe: January Coffee Morning Networking was dedicated to Ranka Sarenac's presentation on Compassionate Parenting (Non-Violent Communication)

"There is a key to every child that leads us to understand, appreciate, respect and hold with compassion his/her personality, his/her way of being in this world." Ranka Sarenac gave us some hints about how to get a hold of that key for our own child or children.

She talked about non - violent communication and how it applies to both our family and school life through the perspective of the parent, the child and the adult in general; about the benefits of differentiating our observations from evaluations, of identifying feelings and needs underpinning our actions, of making clear requests for establishing a contact and/or taking a concrete positive action.

Ranka Šarenac, graduated Psychologist and Trainer, developed her program "SeeMe" in order to support parents and professional educators to behave with children the way they want them to behave towards others: with understanding, respect and compassion.
