3. Teachers' vacancies

We are aware that some teachers are missing in some classes, especially English speaking teachers. Please note that the School was informed by some teachers at very short notice that they would not be starting work in September. Therefore, the School has started a new recruitment process to replace these teachers and it is doing its best to fill the vacancies as soon as possible. In some sections in Secondary, some seconded teachers have not yet arrived, but they should be starting at the School soon.

APEEEL2 is currently following up on these issues with the School Management. We will particularly monitor the difficulties met by the School to recruit new teachers at the Administration Board and with Interparents.

- ✓ We are **directly involved in the decision-making process of all aspects of School life**, and can therefore serve as a channel of communication to members of the School Management team, as well as, via INTERPARENTS, also to the Board of Governors in Brussels, by passing on your ideas and suggestions, relaying your questions and drawing attention to problems.
- ✓ We are **active participants in the Education Councils**, as well as in the School Advisory Council and Administration Board meetings, and in the Canteen, Health and Safety, Library Committees.
- ✓ We **communicate important information** about the School.
- ✓ We provide **advice to parents on different issues** (bullying and discipline, choice of options, Educational Support, ONL, SWALS etc.).
- ✓ We **provide support** to, and work alongside the School, in the organisation of various activities and events (CoMoNe, School Fête, BAC ceremony) as well as specific initiatives (Careers' Day, talks for parents).
